1. Purpose

To ensure that visibility at intersections and corners is not obscured by fences or vegetation.

2. Scope

This Policy applies to all streets and roads within the Council area.

3. Policy

All fences, hedges and other plantings should be set back a minimum of six (6) metres from any corner or junction, unless the fence, hedge or planting is less than one (1) metre above natural ground level.

4. Responsibilities

The Director of Environmental Services will be responsible for the implementation and monitoring of this Policy.

5. Review

This Visibility at Corners Policy shall be reviewed by the District Council of Grant at minimum every four (4) years, within 12 months of a general election (or on significant change to legislation or other matters which could affect this policy).
